Good day families,

Following the conclusion of our ThoughtExchange online conversation last month, and the subsequent analysis as part of our review of the Mobile Central High School feeder system, we are sharing a report on the results with you.

Through ThoughtExchange, the District invited participants to share thoughts and rate the thoughts of others. As you know, this review is underway to examine the potential to reconfigure St. Bernard's Elementary to a Kindergarten to Grade 4 school, with the Grade 5s being assigned to Mobile Central High School. The District was very pleased to have more than **180 participants** share over **370 thoughts** with nearly **14,000 ratings**.

All information gathered will help inform Board Trustees as they prepare to make a decision during the April 13, 2019 meeting of the Newfoundland and Labrador English School Board.
