As a follow up to the ongoing review of the attendance zones for East Point Elementary and Mary Queen of Peace Elementary, I am writing to inform members of both school communities that the Newfoundland and Labrador English School District has updated the website pertaining to this review.

The website now contains an information booklet which provides background on the schools, reconfiguration options, and the 2025 opt-out provision for current students is explained. A feedback form, a presentation recently made to the school councils of both schools, and information about an upcoming information session are also available. It is extremely important for members of the school community to provide feedback to the Board of Trustees during this process and an online feedback form has been established at the link above. The District will hold an information session on September 28, 2017 to provide a briefing on the information package provided. This session will be held in the gymnasium of Mary Queen of Peace Elementary and begin at 6:30 p.m. Members of the school community who would like to receive the information package as a presentation by District staff are invited to attend this session.
