As we have now concluded our second and final ThoughtExchange online conversation as part of the Holy Spirit High and Mount Pearl Senior High school feeder system review, we are sharing a report with you on the results of the exchange.

Using ThoughtExchange, the District invited participants to share their thoughts and rate the views of others on <u>the District's planned configuration</u>. These plans have been made in anticipation of the opening of the new intermediate school in Paradise, expected in the 2021-22 school year. Some great points for consideration were shared by those who actively engaged and we thank you for your participation and consideration!

We have heard the points you have raised and have responded to some of the perspectives shared. These responses are being provided to you in the results website below for your review. You will notice that we have not commented on all thoughts, as many people shared similar ideas, but we have responded to a sample of the concerns and suggestions raised.
