

ST. JAMES REGIONAL HIGH SCHOOL SYSTEM REVIEW



BACKGROUND

The Board of Trustees has directed the staff of the Newfoundland and Labrador English School District (NLESD) to review the St. James Regional High school system with the potential for the closure of LeGallais Memorial starting in 2018-19 school year.

CURRENT CONFIGURATION

The St. James Regional High school system consists of Douglas Academy (K-9) in La Poile, LeGallais Memorial (K-9) in Isle aux Morts, St. James Elementary (K-6) in Port aux Basques, and St. James Regional High (7-12) in Port aux Basques. Grandy's River Collegiate (K-12) is a single-school system in Burnt Islands.

LEGALLAIS MEMORIAL

- LeGallais Memorial is a K-9 school with four classrooms
- School has an enrolment of 47 students.
- School was constructed in 1988, with an extension in 1989.

ST. JAMES ELEMENTARY

- St. James Elementary is a K-6 school with 15 classrooms.
- School has an enrolment of 268 students.
- School was constructed in 1990.

ST. JAMES REGIONAL HIGH

- St. James Regional High is a 7-12 school with 13 classrooms.
- School has an enrolment of 306 students.
- School was constructed in 1984, with extensions in 1990 and 1994, and renovations in 2005.

GRANDY'S RIVER COLLEGIATE

- Grandy's River Collegiate is a K-12 school with 12 classrooms.
- School currently has 99 students.





ENROLMENT PROJECTIONS AND ROOM REQUIREMENTS

Enrolment projections were conducted by NLESD using Baragar Systems, a custom planning software suite for use by school districts across Canada.

Room requirements are calculated on the basis of maximum class caps. For example, the class cap in primary grades is 25 students, so if there were 50 students projected in Grade 2, this means the room requirement would be listed as two rooms of 25 students per class. However, if there were 51 students projected for the next year in Grade 3, the room requirement would be listed as three rooms of 17 students per class. Combined classes of up to 18 students for grades 1 to 6 are assumed and included in room requirement calculations. Senior high classes have no official cap; these room requirement calculations assume a cap of 30. Schools with less than 25 students may use multi-grading, in which the cap on number of students depends on the grade configuration.

LEGALLAIS MEMORIAL

Assuming its current K-9 configuration, the enrolment projections for LeGallais Memorial are shown in Figure 1 below.

The projection model shows enrolment decreasing to a low of 25 by 2026. The school uses multi-grade classes and will require a maximum of four rooms in 2017 and 2018, decreasing to three rooms thereafter.

ST. JAMES ELEMENTARY

Assuming its current K-6 configuration, the enrolment projections for St. James Elementary are shown in Figure 2 below.

The projection model shows enrolment varying between a high of 280 in 2019 and a low of 262 in 2026. This enrolment trend indicates a need for a maximum of 15 classrooms in 2019.

ST. JAMES REGIONAL HIGH

Assuming its current 7-12 configuration, the enrolment projections for St. James Regional High are shown in Figure 3 below.

The projection model shows enrolment decreasing to a low of 222 in 2024. This enrolment trend indicates a need for a maximum of 12 classrooms in 2018 and 2019.

GRANDY'S RIVER COLLEGIATE

Assuming its current K-12 configuration, the enrolment projections for Grandy's River Collegiate are shown in Figure 4 below.

The projection model shows enrolment decreasing to a low of 69 in 2026. The school uses multi-grade classrooms and will require a maximum of 6 classrooms after the current year.

OPTION 1: ACCOMMODATE LEGALLAIS MEMORIAL STUDENTS IN ST. JAMES REGIONAL HIGH SCHOOL SYSTEM

LeGallais Memorial would close and K-6 students would attend St. James Elementary and Grades 7-12 students would attend St. James Regional High.

ACCOMMODATING LEGALLAIS MEMORIAL (K-6) AT ST. JAMES ELEMENTARY

Enrolment projections for the combined K-6 enrolments of LeGallais Memorial and St. James Elementary are shown in Figure 5 below.

The addition of LeGallais Memorial students does not affect the maximum room requirement of 15 at St. James Elementary.

ACCOMMODATING LEGALLAIS MEMORIAL (7-9) AT ST. JAMES REGIONAL HIGH

Enrolment projections for the combined 7-12 enrolments of LeGallais Memorial and St. James Regional High are shown in Figure 6 below.

The addition of LeGallais Memorial students to St. James Regional High does not affect the maximum room requirement of 13.

PROGRAMMING AND SERVICES

As LeGallais Memorial continues to decline in enrolment, it will continue to also experience a decrease in teaching units. The school will be challenged to maintain its present level of services and resources to students. A reduction in the number of teaching units will provide less opportunity for collaboration among teachers and more teaching outside their area of expertise.

CLASS COMPOSITION

LeGallais Memorial has one class for Grades 1-4, one class for Grades 5-7, one class for Grades 8-9.

St. James Elementary consists of two English stream classes in Grades K-6.

St. James Regional High consists of Grade 7 to Level IV, with two English stream classes in Grades 7-9.

Consolidating LeGallais Memorial with St. James Elementary and St. James Regional High would provide more opportunity for teacher collaboration at all grade levels.

CORE CURRICULUM

St. James Elementary and St. James Regional High offer the required curriculum as set by the Department of Education. St. James Regional High offers a large range of general, academic, and advanced senior high courses. Both schools have enhanced learning spaces such as a fully equipped music room, library, and technology lab.

Consolidating LeGallais Memorial with St. James Elementary and St. James Regional High would allow students to be taught by more teachers trained in specialty areas such as physical education, technology, music, French, and special education.

CO-CURRICULAR AND EXTRA-CURRICULAR PROGRAMMING

St. James Elementary and St. James Regional High provide a variety of extra-curricular, co-curricular, and intramural activities and programs which may be available to students if consolidation of schools occurs.

STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES

Student Support Services staff in a larger school would allow for more flexibility in supporting students with diagnosed exceptionalities.

TRANSPORTATION

- 1. Transportation Description
 - a. Regular Transportation current service for St. James Elementary/St. James Regional High:
 - i. Six 70 passenger buses (contracted)
 - ii. One minibus (contracted)
 - b. Regular transportation current service for LeGallais Memorial:
 - i. None
 - c. Change in Requirements if LeGallais Memorial closed:
 - . One additional bus (required for K-6 students to attend St. James Elementary)
- 2. Distances
 - a. Isle aux Morts is 23 kilometres from Port aux Basques and high school students from that community are presently bused to Port aux Basques. The Grades 7-9 students would travel on this bus.
- 3. Estimated Cost Increase
 - a. \$45,000 for additional bus to travel to St. James Elementary

FINANCES

Closing LeGallais Memorial would result in a potential savings of \$146,000 in operating costs (as shown in Figure 7), up to 4 teaching units, and 0.50 administration units. Busing for K-9 students to Port aux Basques would require an additional \$45,000 per year. This results in a total yearly savings of \$551,000.

OPTION 2: ACCOMMODATE LEGALLAIS MEMORIAL STUDENTS IN GRANDY'S RIVER COLLEGIATE SCHOOL SYSTEM

LeGallais Memorial would close with K-9 students to attend Grandy's River Collegiate, beginning September 2018. Senior high students attending St. James Regional High in 2018-2019 would remain until graduation in 2021.

Commencing in the 2019-2020 school year, all senior high students of LeGallais Memorial catchment would attend Grandy's River Collegiate.

ACCOMMODATING LEGALLAIS MEMORIAL AT GRANDY'S RIVER COLLEGIATE

Enrolment projections for the combined K-6 enrolments of LeGallais Memorial and Grandy's River Collegiate are shown in Figure 8 below.

Enrolment projections show that the addition of LeGallais Memorial students initially increases enrolment at Grandy's River Collegiate, decreasing thereafter from a high of 130 in 2018 to a low of 107 in 2026. The school uses multi-grade classes and would require a maximum of nine rooms.

REMOVAL OF LEGALLAIS MEMORIAL AS A FEEDER FOR SENIOR HIGH AT ST. JAMES REGIONAL HIGH

Enrolment projections for St. James Regional High with the removal of LeGallais Memorial as a feeder school to senior high are presented in Figure 9 below.

Removing LeGallais Memorial as a feeder to senior high results in one fewer room required at St. James Regional High in some years; however, it does not change the maximum requirement of 12 rooms.

PROGRAMMING AND SERVICES

As LeGallais Memorial continues to decline in enrolment, it will continue to also experience a decrease in teaching units. The school will be challenged to maintain its present level of services and resources to students. A reduction in the number of teaching units will provide less opportunity for collaboration among teachers and more teaching outside their area of expertise.

CLASS COMPOSITION

LeGallais Memorial has one class for Grades 1-4, one class for Grades 5-7, one class for Grades 8-9.

Grandy's River Collegiate has one class for Grades K-1, one class for Grades 2-3, one class for Grades 4-6, one class for Grades 7-8, one class for Grade 9, and three classes for senior high.

Consolidating LeGallais Memorial with Grandy's River Collegiate would provide more opportunity for teacher collaboration at all grade levels.

CORE CURRICULUM

Grandy's River Collegiate offers the required curriculum as set by the Department of Education.

Consolidating LeGallais Memorial with Grandy's River Collegiate would allow students to be taught by more teachers trained in specialty areas such as physical education, technology, music, French, and special education.

CO-CURRICULAR AND EXTRA-CURRICULAR PROGRAMMING

Grandy's River Collegiate provides a variety of extra-curricular, co-curricular, and intramural activities and programs which may be available to students if consolidation of schools occurs.

STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES

Student Support Services staff in a larger school would allow for more flexibility in supporting students with diagnosed exceptionalities.

- 5. Distances
 - a. Isle aux Morts is 11 kilometres from Burnt Islands.
- 6. Estimated Cost Increase
 - a. \$45,000 for the additional bus

Senior high students living in the former LeGallais Memorial catchment attending St. James Regional High in the 2018-19 school year will continue to receive transportation until June 2021.

FINANCES

Closing LeGallais Memorial would result in a potential savings of \$146,000 in operating costs (as shown in Figure 7), 1 teaching unit, and 0.50 administration units. Busing students to Burnt Islands would require an additional \$45,000 per year. This results in a total yearly savings of \$251,000.
