This information is a follow-up to the October 31, 2019 and December 2, 2019 memos regarding the review of the Holy Trinity High school system.

Please note below the motion which was voted on and passed for your school system during the December 7, 2019 regular public meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Newfoundland and Labrador English School District:

MOTION: Holy Trinity High School System, Holy Trinity High, (8-12), Juniper Ridge Intermediate (5-7), Holy Trinity Elementary (K-4), Cape St. Francis Elementary (K-4) :

WHEREAS the Newfoundland and Labrador English School District is committed to providing the best possible educational programs for students; and

WHEREAS a reconfiguration of grading in the Holy Trinity High School System is required to achieve that objective;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that:

Holy Trinity High School will be reconfigured from Grades 8-12 to Grades 9-12 and Juniper Ridge Intermediate will be reconfigured from Grades 5-7 to Grades 5-8 effective for the 2020-2021 school year.
