Dear families and school community members:

Please be advised that at the October 26, 2019 meeting of the Newfoundland and Labrador English School Board, trustees voted to undertake a review of the **Stephenville High school system** for potential adjustment of catchment areas, grade reconfigurations, and/or closures in anticipation of the upcoming school year (September, 2020). While the school review is in its initial stages, the process will include consultation with school councils, administrators and the school communities.

District officials will be in touch with the school administrations of all schools within the Stephenville High school system (<u>Stephenville Primary</u>, <u>Stephenville Elementary</u>, <u>Stephenville Middle</u>, <u>St. Thomas Aquinas</u>, <u>Pathfinder Learning Center</u>, and <u>Stephenville High School</u>) in the coming days to arrange an initial discussion with school councils before further information is shared with the school community.
