

## Student Registration for Summer School 2018 Grades 7- Level II (Avalon Region)

## **Metro Area Summer School Sites:**

- O'Donel High School, Mount Pearl (Grade 7 to Level II)
- Leary's Brook Junior High, St. John's (Grade 7 to Level II)

Please note: If the registration numbers are low for a specific course at one site, students will be requested to transfer to the other site.

- 1. Registration for Summer School 2018 will take place on **Tuesday July 3<sup>rd</sup>**, **from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m**. at O'Donel High School and Leary's Brook Junior High.
- 2. Classes are tentatively scheduled to begin on **Thursday July 5<sup>th</sup>**, **2018** and will run daily from 9:00 a.m. to 12:15 p.m. Classes finish on **Wednesday August 1<sup>st</sup>**, **2018**. There will be a 15 minute recess break each day. No holidays will be observed.
- 3. Students will not be permitted to register after Monday July 9th, 2018

## Avalon West Summer School Site:

- Ascension Collegiate (Grade 7 to Level II)
- 4. Registration for Summer School 2018 will take place on **Friday June 29**th, **from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.** at Ascension Collegiate.
- 5. Classes are **tentatively** scheduled to begin on **Tuesday July** 3<sup>rd</sup>, **2018** and will run daily from 9:00 a.m. to 12:15 p.m. Classes finish on **Monday July** 30<sup>th</sup>, **2018**. There will be a 15 minute recess break each day. No holidays will be observed.
- 6. Students will not be permitted to register after Friday July 6th, 2018

## **Information for All Sites:**

- 7. The registration fee is \$185.00 per course. Registration fees must be paid on Registration Day. No personal cheques will be accepted. Payment can be made by Cash, Visa, MasterCard or Debit. Course registration is non-refundable unless a course is not offered or a particular site is unavailable. A Financial Assistance Form will also be available during the on-site registration process.
- 8. A student may register for a maximum of one course. Courses will be offered in Grades 7- Level II, where numbers warrant, in the following areas: English Language Arts, Mathematics and Science.
- 9. Textbooks for students at all grade levels will be provided at each site on a sign-out basis.
- 10. Bus Transportation will not be available for either site.
- 11. Canteen service may not be provided, so students are expected to bring snacks from home.
