Registration Process:

- Registration will take place on Friday, June 28th from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. online via the following link: https://goo.gl/X27P3x
- Please note that link will not be active until 9:00 a.m. on Friday, June 28th.
- The registration fee is \$185.00 per course. Registration fees must be paid on July 2nd between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. at the NLESD Central Regional Office, 203 Elizabeth Drive, Gander. Payment can be made by **cash only**. No personal cheques will be accepted. Course registration is non-refundable unless the course is not offered. A Financial Assistance Form will be available during the on-site registration process.
- Math 1201 course will be offered where numbers warrant.
- Please sign out the required Math 1201 textbook from your school on or before June 28th.
- Please indicate your NLESD student e-mail address (studentname@nlesd.ca) on the registration form. Parent/guardian email addresses will also be collected during the registration process. Access to the online course site will be communicated to you via your NLESD student e-mail address and parent/guardian address.
- Classes are tentatively scheduled to begin on Thursday, July 4th and will run daily from 9:00 a.m. to 12:15 p.m. Classes finish on Wednesday, July 31st. There will be a 15-minute break each day. No holidays will be observed.
