



- Recognizing you may belong to more than one of the following groups, please choose the one that most appropriately describes your role in this exchange.






Demographics





Letter from Pearce JH School Council to NLESD staff

On Nov. 25th, 2019, a letter was sent from the School Council of Pearce Junior High to the Director of Facilities & Custodial Management for the NLESD.

This letter describes the Council's concerns with a potential closure of Pearce Junior High and statements made by NLESD staff regarding the physical structure of the school.

A copy of the letter has been made available to all Trustees through the board information package.

Director of Facilities & Custodial Management replied via email to the council to indicate that there are no issues affecting the health and safety of students and staff. However, he did indicate that facilities staff have identified an issue with water infiltration into the physical structure of the school. No air quality issues have been identified for this school

Proposed Configuration Change 1

Proposed Reconfiguration of Marystown Central High

Pearce Junior High (grades 8 and 9) will be scheduled to close as of June 26, 2020. Beginning in September 2020, Marystown Central High will be reconfigured from a grades 10-12 school to a grades 8-12 school and the catchment zone will include all grades 8 and 9 students in the system.

Transportation

Current configuration uses 22 buses to perform 33 runs for all schools in the system.

Current longest run time is 60 minutes from Donald C. Jamieson Academy to Garnish/Frenchman's Cove (afternoon run).

Current longest run time to Marystown Central High is 50 minutes from Garnish/Frenchman's Cove.

With Proposed Configuration Change 1, the longest run time would stay the same - 60 minutes from Donald C. Jamieson Academy to Garnish/Frenchman's Cove (afternoon run).

With Proposed Configuration Change 1, the longest run time for Marystown Central High would not change.

The number of required buses would be lower than current.



Proposed Configuration Change 2

Proposed Reconfiguration of Donald C. Jamieson Academy and Sacred Heart Academy

Donald C. Jamieson Academy and Sacred Heart Academy will change to a single feed system for the entire Marystown Central High student attendance zone. Sacred Heart Academy will be reconfigured from a grade K-7 school to a grade K-4 school; Donald C. Jamieson Academy will be reconfigured from a grade K-7 school to a grade 5-7 school.

Transportation

Current configuration uses 22 buses to perform 33 runs for all schools in the system.

Current longest run time is 60 minutes from Garnish/Frenchman's Cove to Donald C. Jamieson Academy (afternoon run). The longest run time from Sacred Heart Academy is 40 minutes from Red Harbour.

With Proposed Configuration Change 2, the longest run time would be 60 minutes from Red Harbour to Donald C. Jamieson Academy. This may be reduced to 50 minutes based on bell times.

The longest run for Sacred Heart Academy would increase from 40 minutes to 50 minutes.

The number of required buses should not exceed current use.



If both proposed changes are implemented, this will be the system configuration.

Pearce Junior High, 8-9 will close effective June 2020.

BE IT THEREFORE FURTHER RESOLVED that:

Marystown Central High will be reconfigured from grades 10-12 to grades 8-12.

BE IT THEREFORE FURTHER RESOLVED that:

Students attending Pearce Junior High will attend Marystown Central High (8-12) effective September, 2020.

Notice of Motion

WHEREAS the Newfoundland and Labrador English School District is committed to providing the best possible educational programs for students; and

WHEREAS a reconfiguration of grading in the Marystown Central High School system is required to achieve that objective;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that:

Sacred Heart Academy will be reconfigured from grades K-7 to grades K-4.

Donald C. Jamieson Academy will be reconfigured from grades K-7 to grades 5-7.

Effective September 2020, students will attend the appropriate school in accordance with the new grade configuration. Sacred Heart Academy student attendance zone will be rezoned to include the current student attendance zone for Grades K-4 for Donald C. Jamieson Academy. Donald C. Jamieson Academy student attendance zone will be rezoned to include the current student attendance zone for Grades 5-7 for Sacred Heart Academy.

- Initiation
 - NLESB motion directing District staff to review specific schools and/or school systems
 - Phase 1 Consultation
 - Presentation to, and discussion with, School Council(s) (Local Trustee can participate)
 - Information provided on public website
 - Collect community feedback (Feedback Round 1)
 - 1st Board Decision
 - Board reviews information collected and feedback
 - Board reviews staff rationale for recommendation
 - Board <u>Notice of Motion</u> of any proposed changes



- Phase 2 Consultation
 - Updated information online with District Staff rationale
 - Further feedback opportunity (Feedback Round 2)
 - Public presentations to Board/Public meeting
 - <u>2nd Board Decision</u>
 - Board reviews information and feedback
 - Board votes on Motion
