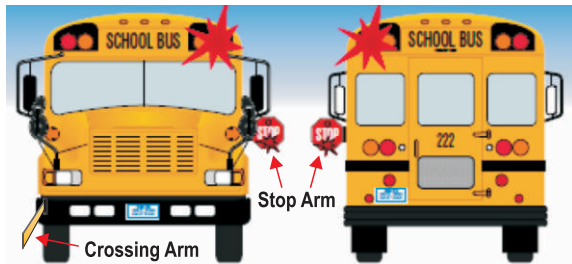


CROSSING THE STREET



- Buses are equipped with crossing arms which extend when the bus is stopped.
- Always cross the street in front of the bus.
- Keep eye contact with the bus driver and wait for the “all clear” signal.
- Check for traffic in both directions.

RED LIGHTS & STOP ARM



Remember that some motorists may not stop for a stopped school bus. In Newfoundland and Labrador, motorists travelling in both directions **in all traffic lanes** must stop when approaching a stopped school bus with its red lights flashing. The penalty for passing a stopped school bus ranges from a fine to six demerit points.
